Breed Suitability Test

The Breed Suitability Test (BST) or ZtP is designed to select those Rottweilers that are worthy of being bred. The dog must be registered with the USRC. The dog's conformation must be free of disqualifying faults according to the FCI international standard for the breed. The hips must be certified to be free of dysplasia by the OFA, GDC, or ADRK. The dog must have a tattoo for identification. The dog must have completed an obedience and temperament test (BH title). Once the conformation and soundness qualifications have been met, the dog's temperament is tested. This test includes a gun sureness test, a protection test, and a test to ensure that the dog is stable around the public. The United States Rottweiler Club strongly believes these tests are vital to maintain the Rottweiler in type and temperament.

BST Requirements:

- Owner and handler must be members of USRC.
- Dog must be registered with USRC. 2.
- Dog must be at least 18 months old. 3.
- Dog must have a tattoo.
- Dog must have passed the Schutzhund BH. 5.
- Dog must have a weight certificate from a vet. 6.
- Dog must have a hip certification from OFA (Orthopedic Foundation for Animals), GDC (Genetic Disease Center), or ADRK.

BST Conformation Evaluation and Performance Routine

- The same helper (barring an accident) must work all dogs in an equal manner and should not be overly hard at any time. The stick hits should be moderate; a leathercovered stick must be used. The sleeve cover should be broken in but not mutilated.
- Dogs will be weighed, measured, and critiqued. Character traits of the dog become more or less apparent during the weighing and measuring process.
- The following tests will be done to establish the interaction in a group and sensitivity to noise.
 - The Group The handler with dog on leash walks through a group of five to eight people. The handler and dog return to the center of the group where the dog sits. The group, when instructed by the judge, converges on the dog and handler and remains there until told by the judge to disperse.
 - The Gun The handler and dog walk away from the judge. At a distance of 15 paces, a 22 short blank starter pistol or its equivalent, is fired twice with a short interval in between each shot. Should the dog have a reaction to the gunfire, this exercise may be varied and repeated at the judge's discretion. If the dog continues to show a strong reaction to gunfire, the test is stopped and the dog is deemed unbreedable.
- The handler and dog will report to the judge. The dog's tattoo number will be rechecked before the protection work begins.
- The dog and handler approach the blind on leash. 5.
- 6. At a distance of approximately 30 feet away from the blind the handler removes the dog's leash and holds the dog by the collar.
- The handler continues to approach the blind while holding the dog by the collar.
- At approximately 12 feet from the blind, at a line marked on the ground, the judge will instruct the helper to come out of the blind and attack the handler. The handler 8. must immediately release the dog.
- 9. The handler shall remain at the spot of releasing the dog until told otherwise by the judge.
- 10. The helper shall:
 - Come out immediately from the blind when directed by the judge and attack towards the handler.
 - b. Catch the dog on the sleeve.
 - Drive the dog and apply two stick hits with an interval of 2 to 3 steps between hits.
 - Continue to drive the dog briefly, approximately 3 to 5 paces, until directed by the judge to stop.
- The dog should immediately go to the helper and grip the sleeve and continue gripping the sleeve while being driven.

- When the helper stops, the dog outs, with or without command from the handler.
- When instructed by the judge the handler will go to the dog and put the dog on leash.
- The handler, with the dog on leash, will heel down the field to a blind designated by the judge.
- On instruction from the judge the handler will leave the blind (on leash) and heel to the center of the field. 15.
- With the dog in basic position, the handler will remove the leash and hold the dog by the collar. The dog must remain quietly by the handler's side.
- At the instruction of the judge, the helper will come from behind a blind that was designated by the judge (approximately 40 meters away from the dog and handler) and walk at a normal pace to the center of the field.
- The handler may challenge the helper as he leaves the blind.
- At the center of the field the helper turns and runs towards the dog and handler in a threatening manner. The handler releases the dog.
- The handler shall remain at the spot of releasing the dog until told otherwise by the judge.
- 21. The dog must grip and remain on the sleeve while being driven 4 or 5 paces (no stick hits).
- The helper stops and the dog outs, with or without command.
- When instructed by the judge, the handler goes to the dog. The handler puts the dog on leash and heels back to the judge and reports that the BST is completed.

Additional Information

After an out the dog should guard the helper until the judge instructs the handler to pick up the dog.

The dog must out, with or without command from the handler and without being touched by the handler. The handler may give 3 separate commands to the dog to out. Two of these commands will be from a distance, the third may be closer. If the dog does not out on the third attempt, the dog can not pass. At no time may the handler touch the dog before the dog outs. If the dog is inappropriately touched before the out, the BST is over, the dog may not pass.

If the dog does not grip the sleeve or if the dog should come off during a drive or stick hits, the helper must continue to press the dog. If the dog returns to the sleeve, the test continues. If the dog fails to regrip, the judge will stop the test and the dog cannot pass.
