General Information

1. Copies of support documentation for all accomplishments and titles must be sent in with any entry for the Sieger, Champion or Working classes.
2. Your dogs original registration, hip certification and support documents for all accomplishments and titles MUST be available at the show for inspection at the time of the class.
4. A valid Hip Certification, pass or fail is required on all dogs over the age of 30 months.
5. The USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.

CONFORMATION SHOW INFORMATION

Classes Offered:

This is the National Sieger Show. Youth Sieger/Siegerin, Sieger/Siegerin and National Select Male/Female titles will be awarded. A USRC recognized working title and breed test is required to be named Sieger or Siegerin.

Regular Classes

Puppy Classes: 4-6 Month Male/Female; 6-9 Month Male/Female; 9-12 Month Male/Female

Youth Classes: 12-18 Month Male/Female; 18-24 Month Male/Female

Adult Classes:

Open Male/Female: For all Rottweilers 24 months and older without a Schutzhund or IPO title, a Championship or Sieger/Siegerin title. Must be USRC registered to compete.

Champion Male/Female For all Rottweilers 24 months and older that have earned a Championship. This includes AKC and CKC Champions, International FCI Champions and any champion of Record from a country whose Championship was awarded by an FCI recognized kennel club. Those dogs entering the Champion class that are eligible to be awarded the USRC Sieger or Siegerin title must be USRC registered.

Working Male/Female: For all Rottweilers 24 months and older with a USRC recognized SchH/VP/G/IPO title who have not earned a USRC Sieger or Siegerin title. Must be USRC registered.

Sieger/Siegerin Class: For all Rottweilers 24 months and older that have earned a Sieger or Siegerin title from a USRC National or Regional Show or have been awarded the USRC Universal Sieger or Siegerin title. Dogs eligible to enter the Sieger or Siegerin class may not enter the Open, Champion or Working class; however, the dog may enter the Veteran Class if the dog's age permits.

Veteran Male/Female: For all Rottweilers 7 years or older on the day of the show. Veteran class entries are not eligible for titles and receive only critiques, no ratings or placements.

Kennel Group: Entered by the Kennel owner. Three or more dogs bred by the Kennel Owner and registered with the Kennel Name of the entrant. The Kennel Owner need not be the registered owner of the dogs. All dogs must first be entered in the show's regular classes. Written critiques are not given.

Brood Bitch: Entered by the owner of the brood bitch. The brood bitch and at least two of her produce must appear in the ring. The bitch must have a USRC recognized Breed Test and have been at least 24 months of age at the time of breeding. The class is to be evaluated on the merits of the produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not be the owner of the produce. The produce must first be entered in the show's regular classes. Written critiques are not given.

Stud Dog: Entered by the owner of the stud dog. The stud dog and at least two of his get must appear in the ring. The dog must have a USRC recognized Breed Test and have been at least 24 months of age at the time of breeding. The class is to be evaluated on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. The get must first be entered in the show's regular classes. Written critiques are not given.

ADDITIONAL SHOW INFORMATION

Once a dog is eligible for the Champion, Working or Sieger/Siegerin class, the dog may not enter the Open Class. When a dog is eligible for more than one class, the dog's owner determines the entry. Photocopies of support documents for all titles and accomplishments must be sent with entry; original documents must be available for inspection at the show. A valid Hip Certification, pass or fail is required on all dogs over the age of 30 months.

This is a German style conformation show. The decision of the Judge is final. No dog shall be permitted to enter any class with missing teeth. Dogs born after 6/1/1998 in countries with docking laws must be shown with natural tail.

Dogs are shown in a natural stance; no hand stacking is allowed. Double handling is permitted; no food is allowed in the ring. Adult classes will be moved (run) long enough for the judge to evaluate dogs' movement and fitness. You may change handlers as needed. Event will be held outdoors, rain or shine. Bring your own chairs and anything else you may deem necessary for comfort for you and your dogs. No dogs may be tied out at show site or ringside. Please do not bring unentered dogs to the show grounds. Please use designated areas to exercise your dogs and clean up after them. Dress is informal.

Docked dogs born prior to December 31, 2011 in countries where docking is permitted are eligible for registration, may participate in USRC events and may be bred provided that the dog and its littermates were docked within seven (7) days of birth.

All dogs must be USRC registered and all handlers must be USRC members

ALL OVERNIGHT ENTRIES **MUST** BE MARKED NO SIGNATURE NECESSARY.

BST, LBST, and ABST Information

Copies of the following documents must be submitted with BST entry.

1. Copy of USRC Membership Card for both owner and handler.
2. Copy of USRC Registration for the dog being entered.
3. Copy of scorebook showing titles earned, scorebook number, and full name of dog. If the BH is earned after the close of entries, a copy of the scorebook showing the BH title must be presented to the BST secretary on the day of the Breed Test.
4. Copy of USRC recognized Hip Certification. All dogs must have their permanent identification indicated on their Hip Certification.
5. Copy of any prior BST attempts.
6. Copy of Weight Certificate dated within 30 days of the test date.
7. A copy of the USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.

The following ORIGINAL documents must be submitted to the BST Secretary on the day of the Breed Test. Entry into the BST will not be accepted without presenting these originals prior to taking the test.

1. USRC Membership Card for both owner and handler. A copy of the Membership card will be accepted on the day of the show. This exception to the original document requirements applies to the membership cards only.
2. USRC Registration Certificate for the dog being entered.
3. Scorebook showing titles earned, (minimum BH) scorebook number and full name of dog.
4. USRC recognized Hip Certification. All dogs must have their permanent identification indicated on their Hip Certification.
5. Prior BST attempts.
6. Weight certificate dated within 30 days of the test date.
7. The USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.

USRC Universal Sieger/Siegerin

A. General

This program has been designed to promote Rottweiler breeding in the United States of America, addressing both physical qualities as well as character attributes as the foundation of the true Rottweiler.

1. Beginning with the year 2001, the USRC will recognize and award a "USRC Universal Sieger/Siegerin(year)" as a title for Rottweilers.
2. All Rottweilers owned by members in good standing of the USRC are eligible to receive this title under the following conditions:
 - a. The dog must possess a USRC recognized breed survey.
 - b. The dog must compete at the USRC National Schutzhund Championship that immediately precedes the USRC National Sieger show at which the Universal Sieger/Siegerin title is awarded.
 - c. The dog must receive a passing score with a TSB rating of pronounced at the National Schutzhund Championships.
 - d. Males must be SchH3.
 - e. Females must be minimum SchH1.
3. The dog receiving the highest number of points combined in both events will be declared as the "Universal Sieger/Siegerin(year)". A minimum of 10 points from each event (20 points total) is necessary.
4. Dogs born in USRC registered litters will receive additional 5 points.
5. The following points will be awarded:

Points National Sieger Show Points National SchH Champ.

25 Sieger/Siegerin	25 National Champion
20 V	20 V
15 SG	15 SG
10 G	10 G

6. In the event of several dogs achieving identical points, tie-breakers shall take place in this order:
 - a. The dog bred in the USA under USRC regulations will be favored over any other dog.
 - b. The points received from the National Schutzhund Championships will dominate the other points.
 - c. Males highest protection score dominates.

- d. Female's higher degree dominates, in the case that the females are of the same degree level, the higher protection score dominates.
7. The Universal Sieger/Siegerin is an important title for our breeding goals and will therefore be recognized on the registration/pedigree of the winner and any progeny bred under the breeding rules of the USRC, as well as entered into the breed book.
8. The Universal Sieger/Siegerin title does allow entry into the Sieger/Siegerin class of USRC conformation shows.
9. The Universal Sieger/Siegerin title will appear at the front of the dog's registered name, listed as "US'yr"
10. The Universal Sieger/Siegerin will be recognized on the front cover of the USRC magazine within the following year of winning the award.
11. The person handling the Universal Sieger/Siegerin in the National Sieger show will receive a trophy award immediately following the declaration.
