General Information

1. Copies of support documentation for all accomplishments and titles must be sent in with any entry. USRC registration is proof of titles earned if titles are on the registration.
2. Your dog's original registration, hip certification and support documents for all accomplishments and titles MUST be available at the show for inspection at the time of the class.
4. A valid Hip Certification, pass or fail is required on all dogs over the age of 30 months entered in the show.

SCHUTZHUND CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

This is the 2008 USRC Schutzhund Championship.
National Schutzhund Champion titles will be awarded.

Classes Offered

SchH 1, 2 and 3. ABST and LBST tests are also offered

Entry Qualifications

1. All dogs entering the Championship must be registered with USRC prior to close of entries. A copy of the USRC registration certificate must be included with the dog's entry.
2. The owners and handlers of all dogs entered in the Championship must be USRC members in good standing.
3. All dogs entering the Championship must have a USRC approved scorebook with titles represented officially recorded.
4. All dogs entering the Championship may compete at their current level of title or earn a new title at the next highest level.

General

1. The Championship shall be conducted in accordance with USA Performance Rules and Regulations, except where the following USRC Rules apply:
 - a. A person may not handle more than 2 dogs at a USRC sanctioned trial. This does not include the BH.
3. This is a Championship event and handlers must dress accordingly. For the stadium work this means a collared sport shirt, appropriate pants, and/or wind suit. T-shirts, training vests, sweatpants and/or cut-offs are not acceptable. In case of rain or inclement weather rain gear, collared sweatshirts and/or jackets are allowed.
4. The Championship shall include SchH 1, SchH 2 and SchH 3 competition with SchH 3 entries taking precedent.
5. There will be open helper tryouts. Helpers will provide their own dogs. The President or Vice-President, the Regional Director or the Assistant Regional Director and the Judge will choose the helpers. The Judge will make final placement of helpers and alternates. The host club, in conjunction with the Schutzhund Committee, will ensure that adequate helpers are available for the tryouts. The host club asks that in the interest of fairness, entrants refrain from practicing with helpers who are trying out, and that all helpers interested in trying out bring a current helper book (if available) and any other available documentation.
6. The Schutzhund Committee shall oversee the organization of the championship and ensure the adequacy of the practice fields and trial fields.
7. In any USRC event that requires proper identification a microchip will be allowed in lieu of a tattoo, provided the handler supplies a working scanner.

CONFORMATION SHOW INFORMATION

Classes Offered:

This is the 2008 USRC Schutzhund Championship and North Central Regional Sieger Show. National Schutzhund Champion, Regional Youth Sieger/Siegerin, Regional Sieger/Siegerin and Regional Select Male/Female titles will be awarded. A USRC recognized working title and breed test is required to be named Sieger or Siegerin.

Regular Classes

Puppy Classes: 4-6 Month Male/Female; 6-9 Month Male/Female; 9-12 Month Male/Female

Youth Classes: 12-18 Month Male/Female; 18-24 Month Male/Female

Adult Classes:

Open Male/Female: For all Rottweilers 24 months and older without a Schutzhund or IPO title, a Championship or Sieger/Siegerin title. Need not be USRC registered to compete.

Champion Male/Female: For all Rottweilers 24 months and older that have earned a Championship. This includes AKC and CKC Champions, International FCI Champions and any champion of Record from a country whose Championship was awarded by an FCI recognized kennel club. Those dogs entering the Champion class that are eligible to be awarded the USRC Sieger or Siegerin title must be USRC registered or have applied for registration at the event.

Working Male/Female: For all Rottweilers 24 months and older with a USRC recognized SchH/VPG/IPO title who have not earned a USRC Sieger or Siegerin title. Must be USRC registered or have applied for registration at the event.

Sieger/Siegerin Class: For all Rottweilers 24 months and older that have earned a Sieger or Siegerin title from a USRC National or Regional Show or have been awarded the USRC Universal Sieger or Siegerin title. Dogs eligible to enter the Sieger or Siegerin class may not enter the Open, Champion or Working class; however, the dog may enter the Veteran Class if the dog's age permits.

Veteran Male/Female: For all Rottweilers 7 years or older on the day of the show. Veteran class entries are not eligible for titles and receive only critiques, no ratings or placements.

Kennel Group: Entered by the Kennel owner. Three or more dogs bred by the Kennel Owner and registered with the Kennel Name of the entrant. The Kennel Owner need not be the registered owner of the dogs. All dogs must first be entered in the show's regular classes. Written critiques are not given.

Brood Bitch: Entered by the owner of the brood bitch. The brood bitch and at least two of her produce must appear in the ring. The bitch must have a USRC recognized Breed Test and have been at least 24 months of age at the time of breeding. The class is to be evaluated on the merits of the produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not be the owner of the produce. The produce must first be entered in the show's regular classes. Written critiques are not given.

Stud Dog: Entered by the owner of the stud dog. The stud dog and at least two of his get must appear in the ring. The dog must have a USRC recognized Breed Test and have been at least 24 months of age at the time of breeding. The class is to be evaluated on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. The get must first be entered in the show's regular classes. Written critiques are not given.

ADDITIONAL SHOW INFORMATION

Once a dog is eligible for the Champion, Working or Sieger/Siegerin class, the dog may not enter the Open Class. When a dog is eligible for more than one class, the dog's owner determines the entry. Photocopies of support documents for all titles and accomplishments must be sent with entry; original documents must be available for inspection at the show. A valid Hip Certification, pass or fail is required on all dogs over the age of 30 months.

This is a German style conformation show. The decision of the Körmeister is final. No dog shall be permitted to enter any class with missing teeth. Dogs born after 6/1/1999 in countries with docking laws must be shown with natural tail.

Dogs are shown in a natural stance; no hand stacking is allowed. Double handling is permitted; no food is allowed in the ring. Adult classes will be moved (run) long enough for the judge to evaluate dogs' movement and fitness. You may change handlers as needed. Event will be held outdoors, rain or shine. Bring your own chairs and anything else you may deem necessary for comfort for you and your dogs. No dogs may be tied out at show site or ringside. Please do not bring unentered dogs to the show grounds. Please use designated areas to exercise your dogs and clean up after them. Dress is informal. Trophies will be awarded for 1st thru 4th place in all categories for the show.

Entries will not be considered complete until all supporting documentation and payments have been received. E-mail confirmation will be sent as soon as entry is processed. All checks should be made payable to Central Ohio Rottweiler Club (CORC)

Original supporting documentation should be available for presentation to the trial/show/breed test secretary at check in. Entry into any event will not be allowed if originals are not present for examination. Scorebooks **must** be presented to the trial secretary.

All overnight entries **must** be marked no signature necessary. We are not responsible for timeliness of overnight entries requiring a signature.

BST, ABST, LBST Information

Copies of the following documents **must** be submitted with BST entry.

1. Copy of USRC Membership Card for both owner and handler.
2. Copy of USRC Registration for the dog being entered.
3. Copy of scorebook showing titles earned, scorebook number, and full name of dog. If the BH is earned after the close of entries, a copy of the scorebook showing the BH title must be presented to the BST secretary on the day of the Breed Test.
4. Copy of USRC recognized Hip Certification. All dogs must have their permanent identification indicated on their Hip Certification.
5. Copy of any prior BST attempts.
6. Copy of Weight Certificate dated within 30 days of the test date.
7. A copy of the USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.

For ABST entries:

In addition to the above mentioned membership card, registration and scorebook requirements:

1. Dogs must be 36 months of age, bitches must be 30 months of age.
2. Copy of prior passing BST showing 1a-31 eyes
3. Three (3) show critiques with a SG or V Rating. Two of these critiques must be from the Open, Working, Champion or Sieger Classes and must be from 2 (two) different USRC recognized Judges.
4. A male must have a valid USRC Recognized SchH/VPG/IPO3 title. A bitch must have a valid USRC Recognized SchH/VPG/IPO1 title. Both must have passed an Endurance Test (AD).
5. Dogs may receive an ABST in spite of lost teeth provided copies of the dog's BST and 3 show critiques from adult classes showing complete scissors bite are submitted with the entry and the original documentation is presented on the day of the Breed Test.
6. A scale will be available at the event for ABST and LBST entries.

For LBST entries:

In addition to the ABST requirements, the following must be submitted:

1. Proof of passing ABST
2. Breed warden evaluations for males (3 litters) and bitches (1 litter)

The following ORIGINAL documents must be submitted to the Breed Test Secretary on the day of the Breed Test. Entry into the Breed Tests will not be accepted without presenting these originals prior to taking the test.

1. USRC Membership Card for both owner and handler. A copy of the Membership card will be accepted on the day of the show. This exception to the original document requirements applies to the membership cards only.
2. USRC Registration Certificate for the dog being entered.
3. Scorebook showing titles earned, (minimum BH) scorebook number and full name of dog.
4. USRC recognized Hip Certification. All dogs must have their permanent identification indicated on their Hip Certification.
5. Prior BST attempts.
6. Weight certificate dated within 30 days of the test date.
7. The USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.

UNIVERSAL SIEGER/SIEGERIN PROGRAM

This program has been designed to promote Rottweiler breeding in the United States of America, addressing both physical qualities as well as character attributes as the foundation of the true Rottweiler.

1. Beginning with the year 2001, the USRC will recognize and award a "USRC Universal Sieger/Siegerin(year)" as a title for Rottweilers.
2. All Rottweilers owned by members in good standing of the USRC are eligible to receive this title under the following conditions:
 - a. The dog must possess a USRC recognized breed survey.
 - b. The dog must compete at the USRC National Schutzhund Championship that immediately precedes the USRC National Sieger show at which the Universal Sieger/Siegerin title is awarded.
 - c. The dog must receive a passing score with a TSB rating of pronounced at the National Schutzhund Championships.
 - d. Males must be SchH3.
 - e. Females must be minimum SchH1.
3. The dog receiving the highest number of points combined in both events will be declared as the "Universal Sieger/Siegerin(year)". A minimum of 10 points from each event (20 points total) is necessary.
4. Dogs born in USRC registered litters will receive additional 5 points.
5. The following points will be awarded:

Points	National Sieger Show	Points	National SchH Champ.
25	Sieger/Siegerin	25	National Champion
20	V	20	V
15	SG	15	SG
10	G	10	G

6. In the event of several dogs achieving identical points, tie-breakers shall take place in this order:
 - a. The dog bred in the USA under USRC regulations will be favored over any other dog.
 - b. The points received from the National Schutzhund Championships will dominate the other points.
 - c. Males highest protection score dominates.
 - d. Female's higher degree dominates, in the case that the females are of the same degree level, the higher protection score dominates.
7. The Universal Sieger/Siegerin is an important title for our breeding goals and will therefore be recognized on the registration/pedigree of the winner and any progeny bred under the breeding rules of the USRC, as well as entered into the breed book.
8. The Universal Sieger/Siegerin title does allow entry into the Sieger/Siegerin class of USRC conformation shows.
9. The Universal Sieger/Siegerin title will appear at the front of the dog's registered name, listed as "US'yr"
10. The Universal Sieger/Siegerin will be recognized on the front cover of the USRC magazine within the following year of winning the award.
11. The person handling the Universal Sieger/Siegerin in the National Sieger show will receive a trophy award immediately following the declaration.

REVOLVING TROPHIES

The following revolving trophies will be awarded at the National Schutzhund Championship:

High in Trial: Awarded to the highest scoring passing competitor team regardless of title. Donated by (ADRK Working Judge) Martin and Udo Hillgeman.

High Owner Trained: Awarded to the highest scoring passing handler/owner trained team. Donated by Orville Story.

Ira von Weissen Graben Memorial Trophy for High Scoring Female: Awarded to the highest scoring female to pass regardless of title. Donated by Old Dominion Rottweiler Klub.

Joe Rocco Memorial SCHIII High Protection Trophy: Awarded to the SchH III team with the high protection score and "pronounced" in protection. Must be a passing total score. Donated by Sue Maturo.

The Martin Hillgeman Sportsmanship Trophy: Awarded by the host club to the competitor who has demonstrated good sportsmanship throughout the trial. A passing score is not necessary. Donated by Martin Hillgeman.
